


Figure S1. Dendrogram comparing *flaA*-SVR DGGE profiles from year 1 isolates.




Figure S2. *Campylobacter* phage levels (PFU/g) in caeca (Year 1 and 2) with no enrichment.




Figure S3. Transmission Electron Microscopy of bacteriophage PH388, genome size 145 Kb (negative staining showing the morphology of the phages).



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
